Llangwm Local History Society was founded in 2002 and hosts monthly meetings with both historical talks and visits to places of interest. It has received national recognition and award for its work on local First World War Commemorations.

In 2019 it was the key society in the formation of the Five Communities History Group to catalogue, digitise and share its collection of local archival heritage both within the community and the wider world.

It has also published the book 'Some Remarkable People of Llangwm and Hook' by W Grenville Thomas.

It plays an active role in the local community with events and exhibitions.

This catalogue has been created for Llangwm Local History Society and details items currently held within the collection.

It has been created as part of the Five Communities Group History Project to catalogue and digitize collections of local historical material.

The catalogue is divided into a several 'Sections' each corresponding to a different area of interest or relevance to the particular collection.

The truth of his character, the liberality of his disposition and the kindness of his heart endeared him to relatives, friends and dependants while to her who was for 25 years the companion of his life he has left an ever enduring remembrance of the tenderest affection. Also of his widow who died in her 94th year on November 5th 1914 having survived her husband 48 years.
