Penally History Group is a small group of people devoted to exploring and recording the history of Penally Village and area.

The group was founded in 2010 and hosts monthly meetings. It creates local interest exhibitions on a variety of topics. These have notably included the village's connection to the First World War.

It has also conducted extensive work on the local training trenches and been instrumental in these being designated as a scheduled ancient monument. The group has further produced interpretive leaflets and boards on for the site.

The group is involved in both trips and arranging guest speakers.

This catalogue has been created for Penally History Group and details items currently held within the collection.

It has been created as part of the Five Communities Group History Project to catalogue and digitise collections of local historical material.

The catalogue is divided into a several 'Sections' each corresponding to a different area of interest or relevance to the particular collection.
